Location

The Conference will take place at The Royal Statistical Society which is located near the Barbican Centre, map attached. Please enter via the Errol Street entrance. The nearest tube stations are Moorgate, Old Street, Liverpool Street and Barbican. It is not recommended that you travel to The Royal Statistical Society by car as parking facilities are very limited. The nearest NCP is The Barbican, entrance via Silk Street.

On arrival at the RSS you will be directed to the IMA Registration Desk which will open at 9.30 a.m. Amy Marsh, the IMA Conference Officer, and Sammi Lauesen will be present throughout the day.

Wheelchair Access

All public areas at the RSS are fully wheelchair accessible. However, ramps are required for entry into the building but cannot be kept permanently on the pavement. Please, therefore, contact us in advance so that full assistance can be given where necessary, and so that appropriate arrangements can be made.
