University Liaison Grants Scheme Application Form

The Institute of Mathematics and its Applications (IMA) is keen to increase engagement of university students with the activities of the IMA. As part of this initiative a pilot scheme of small grants has been developed to give university student mathematical societies some funding for various activities to enhance their programme. Grants can be used to support:

- mathematical activities (such as putting on talks of mathematical interest, printing a mathematical newsletter or travelling as a group to IMA general interest conferences or places of mathematical interest);
- careers activities (such as putting on careers or networking events); or,
- promotional activities (such as printing t-shirts, hoodies, sports team shirts, etc. incorporating the IMA logo).
- networking activities, quizzes etc.

The IMA accepts that some of its grant may be used indirectly for events such as pub crawls and Balls. However no more than £100 of the IMA grant should be assigned to either of these activities in any one year.
